


WARNING: PROTECT YOUR FAMILY AND YOURSELF

Did You Know...

Hot water for personal washing should *not* exceed **45°C** as *anything higher can cause major burns*... HOWEVER most hot water systems are set a lot higher than this...



70°C

At 70°C it takes *less than half a second* to scald skin.

60°C

At 60°C it only takes *one second* to scald skin.

55°C

At 55°C it takes *30 seconds* to scald skin.

50°C

At 50°C it takes *5 minutes* to scald skin.

<45°C

A safe temperature to use.
